
Digital Doors

I still remember my surprise in the 1990s when a consultant hired by Furman University said there were three public-facing "front doors" by which people in the community came to know the school. The first two made immediate sense: 1) its campus and 2) its athletic and arts programs. The third one provoked a silent "Whaaaat?" from me: its website. It took a while for my skepticism about the new-fangled "world wide web" to recede, but it did.

On a recent Sunday afternoon, 137 people in South Carolina had entered "Baptist church near me" in a Google search in the previous 24 hours. Another 27 entered "church near me." I can't identify how many of those 164 searches were initiated within a 30-minute drive of Ridgeland Drive (91% of American church-goers drive 30 minutes or less to church). But even a handful of them would represent five individuals or families who might or might not have found our digital "front door."

Evaluating, updating, and promoting the RDBC website is a first task for a new "Digital Communication Team" authorized by the church Council in June. Additional tasks include amplifying our Facebook presence and exploring additional outlets (perhaps Instagram, YouTube, Reddit, a podcast?). Team members include Letha Kay, Rylee Riggins, Jeff Rogers, Erica Zeigler, and Treadwell Ziegler. If you have thoughts about our assignment, please pass them along to us.

Word of mouth and personal invitations still account for the largest percentage of church visitors and new members (more on this in the future!). But especially for people who are new to the area and for "digital natives" (born since the early 1990s), digital doors are how they first meet us and get to know us.
